BOARD OF TRUSTEES MID-TERM ELECTION 2017

The Board of Trustees Mid-Term Election is a postal election and nominations are invited for the election of TWO Parent Representatives. These are the positions currently held by Sandro Kuehne and Fraser Overweel. Both positions are for a **3-year term**, i.e. until the next Mid-Term Election (November 2020).

If you are a parent, guardian or immediate caregiver of a pupil enrolled at Brunswick School you are eligible to vote and your name will be placed on the Parent Representative Electoral Roll.

A **candidate** in a parent representative election **DOES NOT** need to be a parent/caregiver of a student enrolled at school; but **DOES** need to be nominated by a person who is on the Parent Representative Electoral Roll (Voting Roll).

Following is a timeline of events

Mon 30 Oct - Main Voting Roll open for inspection

Wed 1 Nov - Main Voting Roll closes at noon

- Supplementary Roll opens after noon

Fri 3 Nov - Nomination papers sent out to all eligible voters by this date

Wed 15 Nov (noon)- Supplementary Roll closes

Fri 17 Nov (noon) - Nominations Close

- All Candidate Statements must be received by Returning Officer

Wed 22 Nov - Voting papers to be posted out by this date

Fri 1 Dec - Election Day – voting closes at noon

Thu 7 Dec - Votes Counted

- Results declared

Fri 8 Dec - New Board Members take office

Voting Roll

The voting roll will be open for inspection at the school office from Monday 30 October, and can be viewed during all normal school hours, except for Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.

It is your responsibility to check your name is on the roll.

NO NAME = NO VOTE.

The main voting roll closes noon, Wednesday 1st November.

A supplementary roll will open after noon on Wednesday 1st November for every person who becomes eligible to vote in the election after the close of the main roll; or whose name was wrongly omitted from the main roll. The supplementary roll closes at noon on Wednesday 15th November, and no newly eligible or wrongly omitted voters may be included after this date.

Nomination Forms

Nomination forms will be delivered or posted this week to all those on the voting roll.

All Nominations received will be checked for eligibility and candidates' names posted in the school Foyer.
