As you may be aware there is a child at our school who is much more susceptible to infection due to an impaired immune system as a result of treatment.

A reminder to our school community regarding minimising the risk of spreading infections.

We respectfully ask that if your child is unwell that you do not send them to school, or if your child has been in contact with other children who have had chicken pox, mumps or rubella (particularly if your child is not immunised) that you contact the school. This will allow the child who has limited immunity to remain at home if necessary.

To all children, a reminder, a good way to prevent the spread of germs is to wash our hands, especially after going to the bathroom or if you have been coughing or sneezing into your hand. Remember to get your hands clean you must scrub them for 20 seconds or as long as it takes to sing HAPPY BIRTHDAY slowly.
