New Board members take office Friday 8 December.

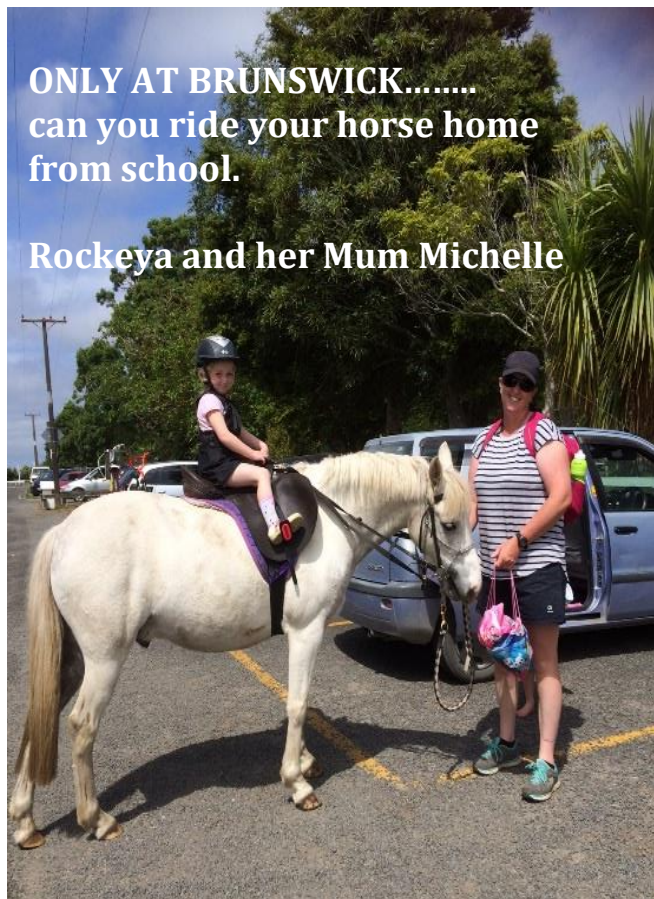
